TACKLING THE VIDEO INTERVIEW

DO'S & DON'TS

- Make sure you have a good internet connection
- Have a blank wall or a simple backdrop behind you (ie. plant, bookshelf)
- Sit in good lighting
- Minimize distractions (for both you and the other person/people in the call)
- Open all necessary web pages prior to the call starting
- Ensure your webcam is on a stable surface
- Know your tech!

- Have a lot going on behind you (possibly distracting who you're speaking with)
- Eat on the call
- Have an un-tidy room in view
- Move around while on the call, or remove your face from camera view
- Turn off the video
- Be too relaxed casual (even if you are at home)
- Forget your headphones
- Dress too casually for the occasion
